This course spans 3 days, providing 21 CE hours, including 3.5 Ethics credits. Course content is consistent with the American Society of Clinical Hypnosis basic & intermediate training guidelines. The course is a mix of didactic presentations, demonstrations, experiential exercises, and opportunity to practice in safe, supervised faculty led small groups. Small group mentored practice is tailored to the learning needs and style of each participant. At the end of the course participants will have been taught the basic skills needed to utilize clinical hypnosis and begin using it in a practice setting.
